Want funding to take a STAND against tobacco and nicotine? Micro-grants of up to \$250 are available for student and youth groups to support one-time educational or advocacy events or activities that work to raise awareness among peers around tobacco, vaping, and nicotine. A few requirements: Groups must be a registered student organization or be sponsored by an organization (such as a school, faithbased organization, or community-based agency) that assumes fiscal responsibility for the funds awarded (we cannot issue a check to an individual); Groups must have an adult advisor who will support the group and act as the adult point of contact for the ALA; Funds can be used to cover expenses related to tobacco, nicotine, or vaping-related education or advocacy events or activities. Expenses may include: printing, buying t-shirts or other giveaways, educational supplies, speaker fees, contest prizes, food and refreshments (no alcohol), equipment rentals, etc.; After your event or activity, you will be asked to submit a paragraph with photo(s) describing your event and a brief expense report (due by June 5, 2020).
